Applications for 2011 are available on www.LSFund.org. Deadline is 6/30/11 for all application criteria to be met.

Eligibility:

Your child *may* be eligible for an LSF scholarship if they meet the following criteria:

1. Is a New Hampshire resident
2. If during the 2010 - 2011 school year, either: Attended public school; or was too young to enroll in public school; or I can no longer afford a non-public education for my children.
3. Will be attending New Hampshire private school or be educated at home for 2010/2011 school year.
4. Is between 5 and 18 years of age as of 09-01-11.

Awards:

Scholarships will be awarded using a random selection from amongst all qualifying applicants on or before 7/15/11. The awards will be in the amount of \$500 per child will be awarded from 8/1/11 - 8/31/11, until all available funds are awarded to NH children.

Every child is unique and deserves to have that uniqueness respected and encouraged. Pursuing educational alternatives is one way to ensure this.
